In 2008 Cole received the Award of Distinction for his work promoting sustainable gardening practices. He worked as curator at the US Nat'l Arboretum and the Minnesota Landscape Arboretum and is devoted to studying native plants in the wild and in gardens. Currently principal of Native Landscape Design & Restoration and a lecturer in the College of Architecture & Landscape Architecture at the U of Virginia, he teaches about plants and their ecological connections to natural systems and cultural landscapes.
